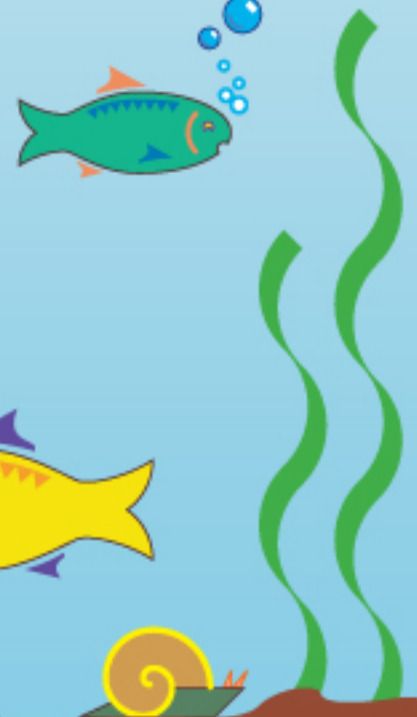

Trash to Treasure

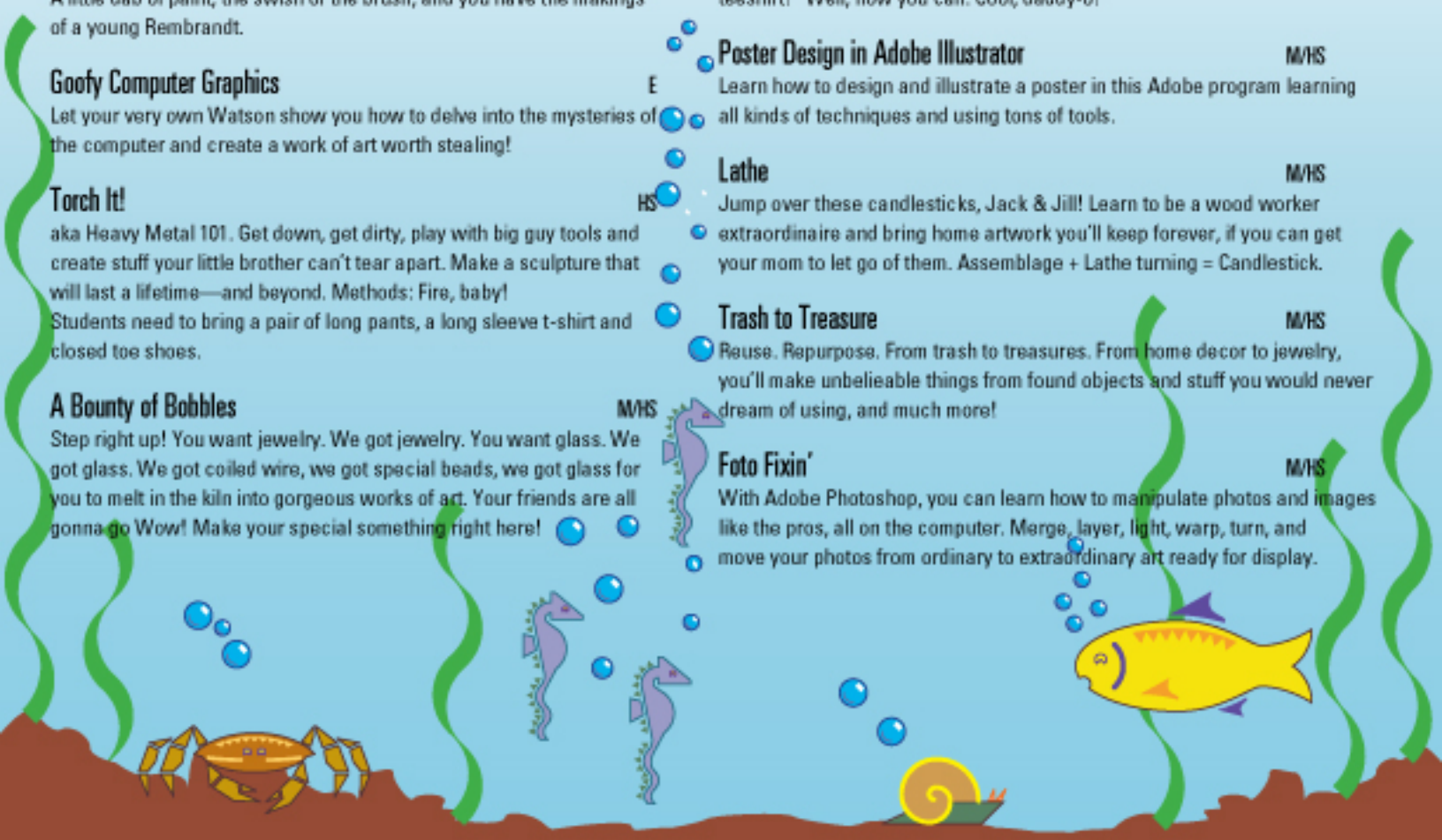
M/HS
