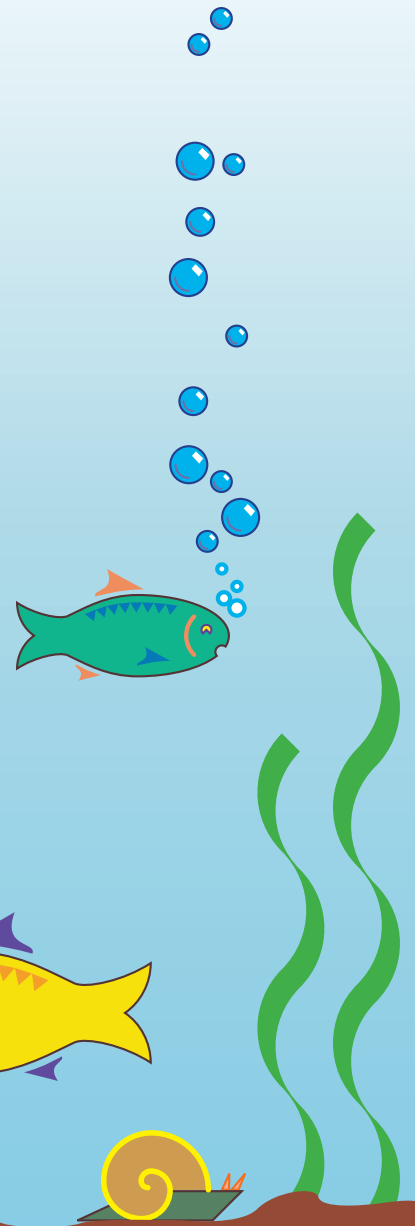

EARLY CAMPER REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS MAY 20.

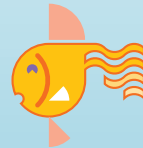

Workshop Descriptions

Hurry! Class Sizes are Limited!

Stained Glass

M/HS

Ever hear of Tiffany? Now you can make your own stained glass wall piece. Who knows, you just might become collectable! (grades 7-12 only)

Beach Bag-a-Mania

Take your art home in style! Stitch an original artist's beach bag using fiber techniques such as: shibori (fancy word, huh?) and stitchery, then embellish (another fancy word for decorate) it with all the doodads you can think of to wow your friends.

Clay Sculpture

Explore hand building in clay, using a variety of techniques and processes. Not quite as messy as throwing on the wheel, but bring your fingernail brushes and apron anyhow!

Wheel Throwing

Crafts Go Green

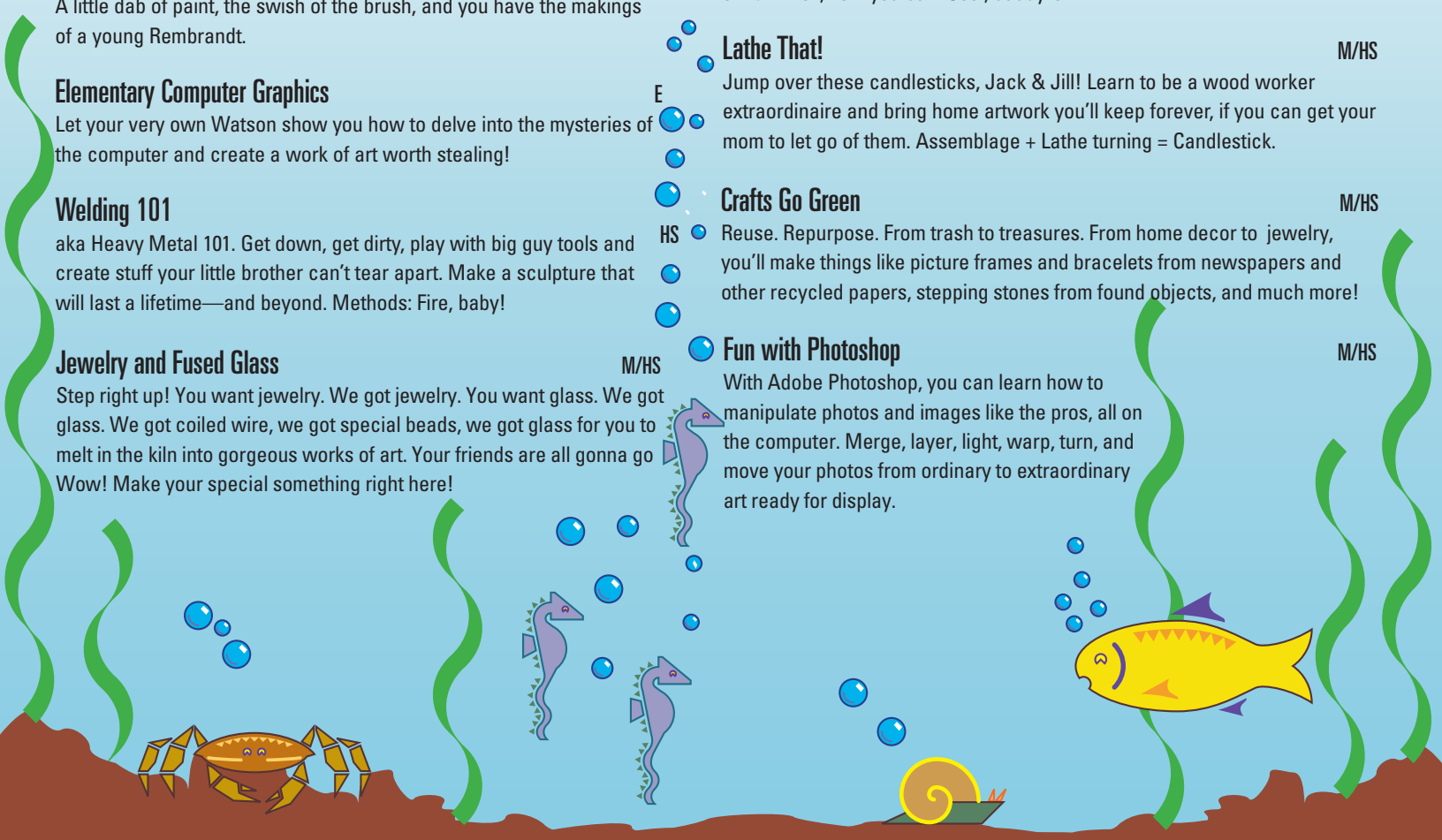
M/HS
