



## Dr. Rash's Class Expectations

- Students are expected to follow all JCPS & Manual HS expectations/rules not listed on this sheet.
- Students are expected to be in the room, in their seats when the bell starts to ring. If a student is not in their seat when the bell starts to ring, they will be marked tardy.
- Students are expected to NOT loiter outside the room door between classes, they are expected to enter the room, take their seat and be ready to start when the bell rings.
- Students are expected to be quiet as they enter/exit the room, NO yelling to people in the hall or classroom.
- Students are expected to remain completely quiet while the teacher is talking. If I can hear anything, it's too loud.
- Students are expected to do their own work on all assignments & not copy or plagiarize for any work, test, etc., completed for this class.
- Students are expected to not adjust/alter the blinds or windows.
- Students are expected to sit facing forward in their assigned seats & not be turned around or leaning against the wall.
- Students are expected to work on my class work during my class. If students have any material out on their desk not related to my class, they can expect that it will be confiscated & possibly destroyed (e.g. HW for another class, magazine, etc.).
- Students are expected to stop whatever they are doing & listen when an announcement is made over the intercom or on the TV (No talking, No whispering of any type).
- At the end of class, students are expected to clean up any paper, etc. around their desk, straighten up the desk if the desk were moved during class & remain seated until the bell rings.
- If the phone rings or someone enters the room, students are expected to stop any talking/whispering that might be occurring & remain completely quiet.
- Students are expected to stay away from the teacher's desk, podium & computer.
- If bottled drinks are brought to class (no cans allowed), students are expected to keep the lid on them to prevent spillage & to discard of the bottles at the end of class. Students (and the entire class) may lose the privilege of having drinks in class if spillage or bottles are found left in the room.
- Students are expected to not have food in class. Items that can be opened & placed entirely in mouth are allowed (gum, mints, etc.). However, if wrappers are left on desk/floor the privilege may be taken away. If gum is "popped", the privilege will be taken away.
- Students are expected to walk up & drop garbage in to the wastebasket (NOT to "Shoot" garbage at the wastebasket).
- At a minimum, students are expected to bring their book, paper & pencil to every class (calculators are strongly suggested).
